PROGRAM

- 7:30 am: Departure from Madirokely and briefing on board before a morning at sea to encounter whale sharks and collect data (depending on the needs and possibilities of the field):

Photo identification and recording of environmental data

Biopsies

Deployment of acoustic and/or satellite tags

Collection of prey samples
